

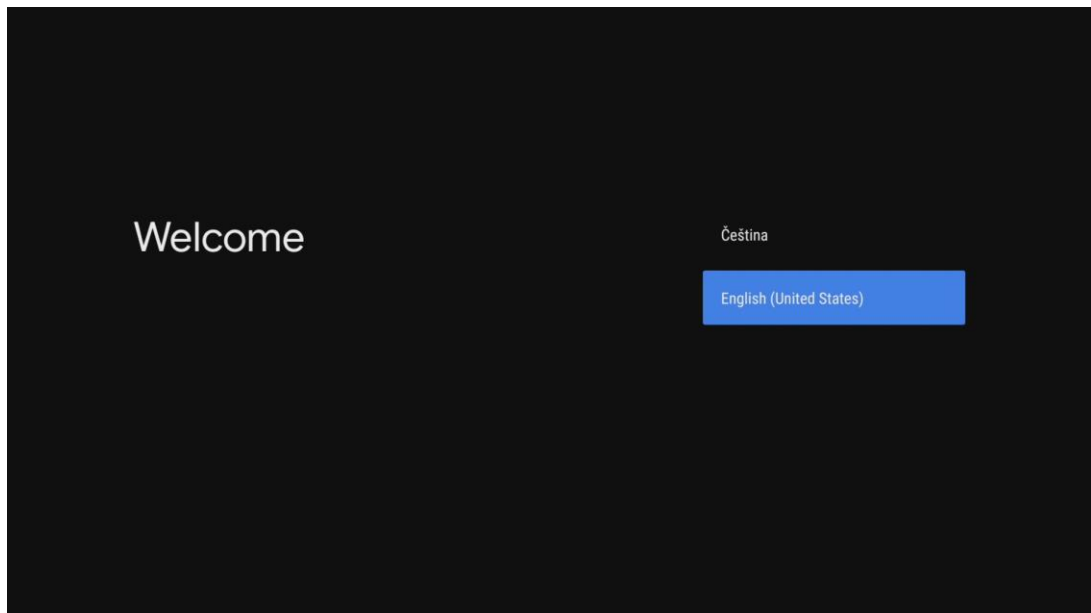



### Setup via Android phone



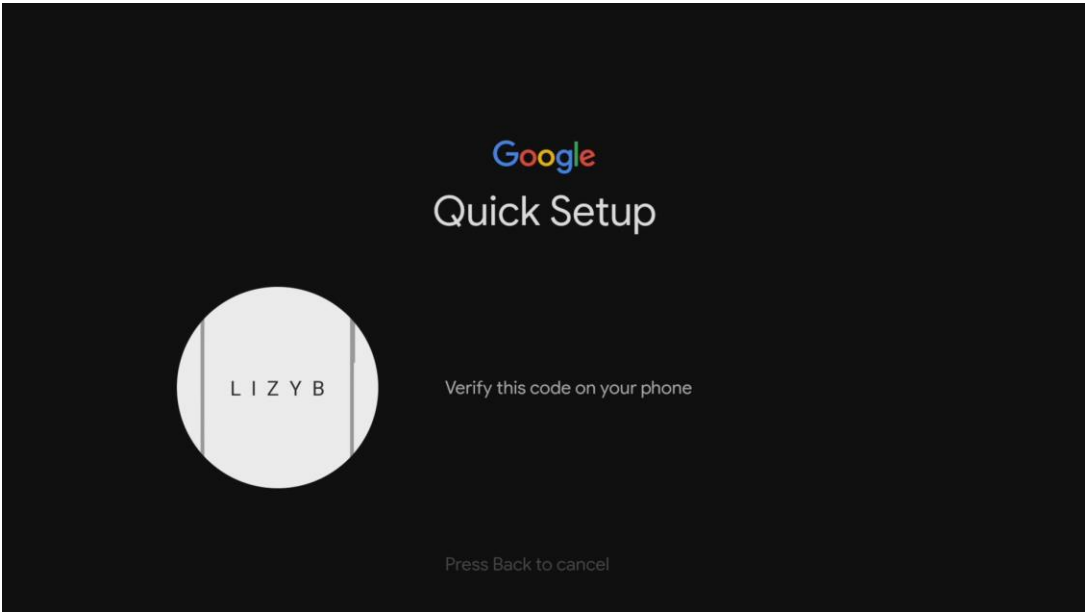
#### Google Quick Setup

1. On your Android Phone, open the pre-installed app "Google"
2. Type or say, "Ok Google, set up my device"
3. Tap Vodafone ... (561) on the list

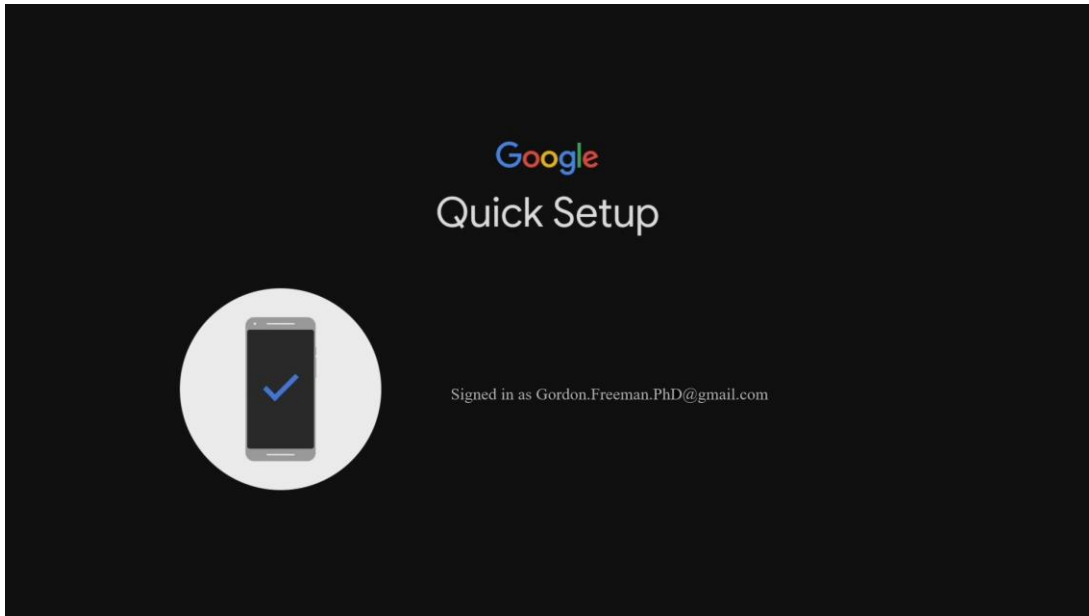
Press Back to cancel

Check if the code on the screen matches with the code on the phone and confirm.

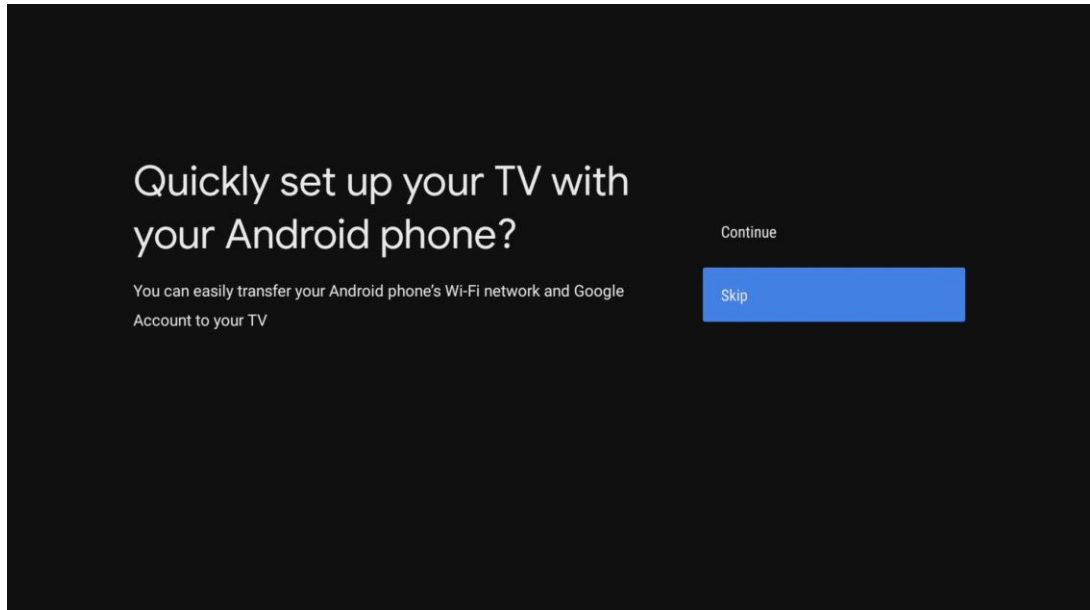

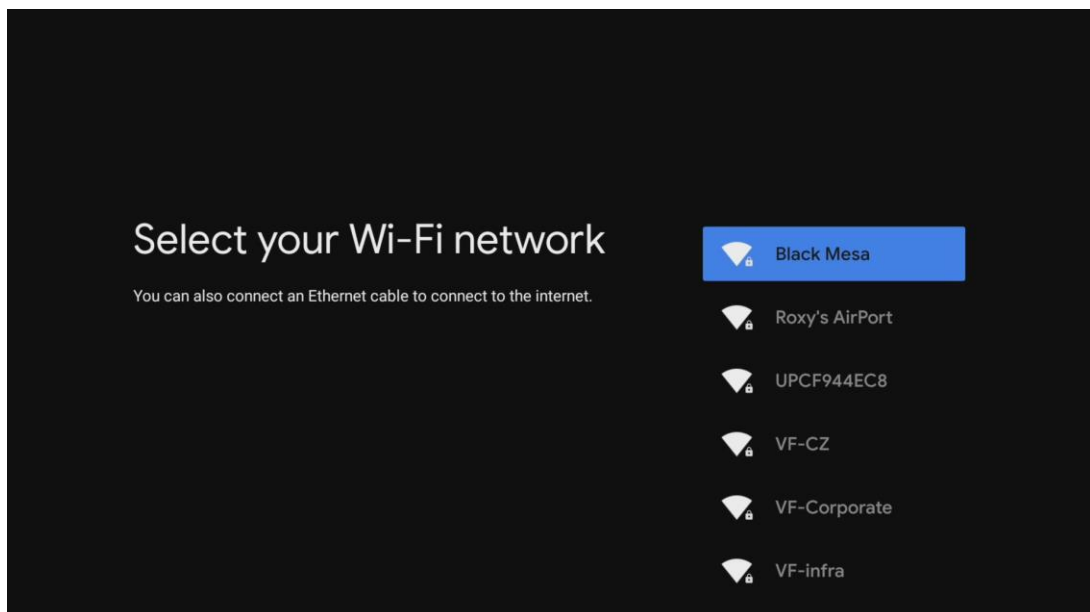
## Settings with/without Google account

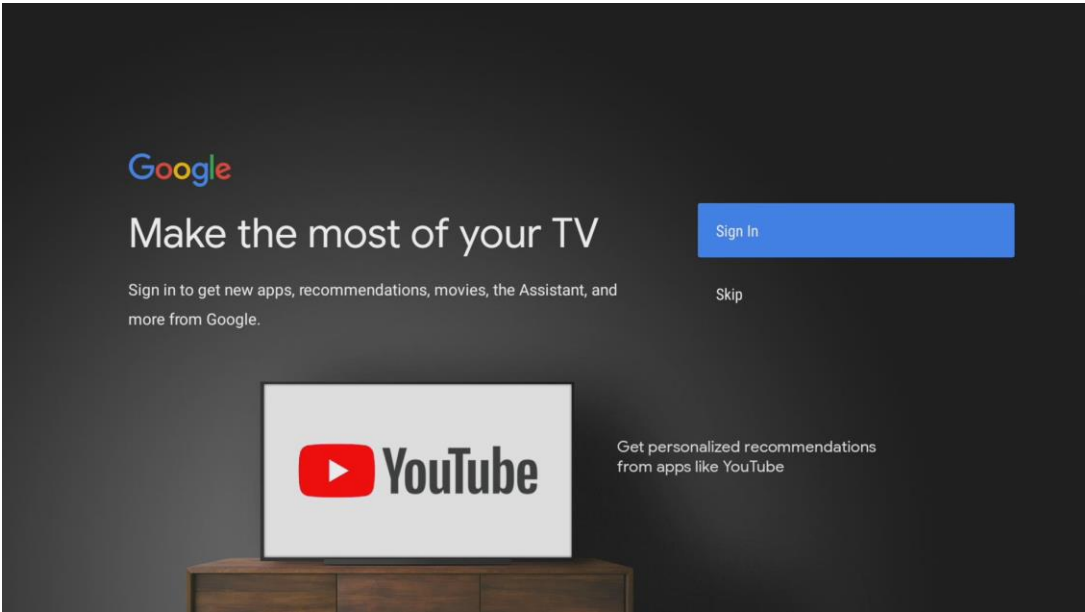
On the initial page, we choose to skip.

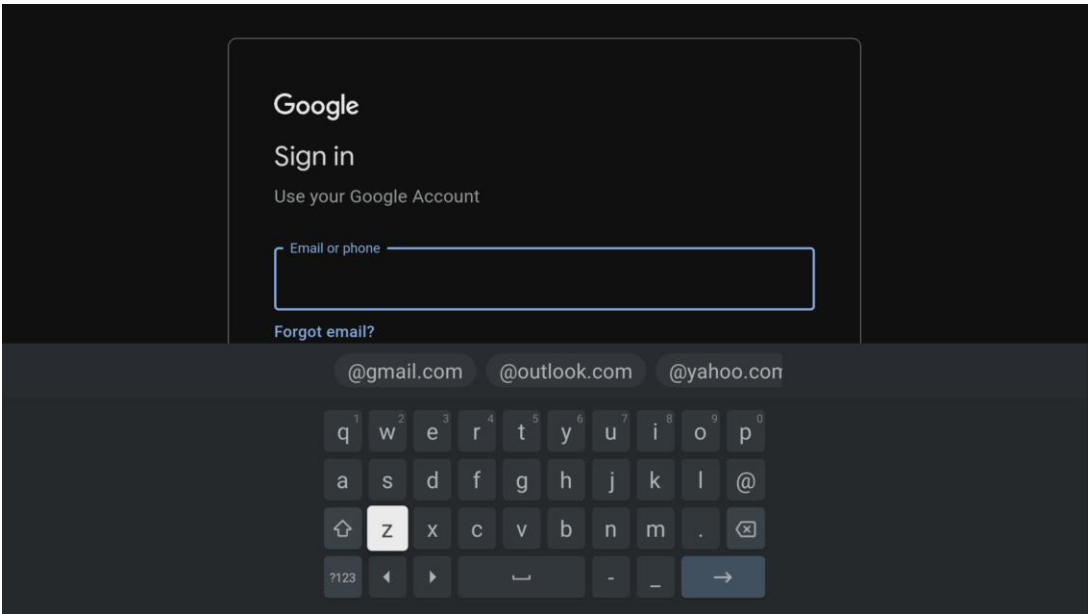


Select your Wi-Fi network, enter the Wi-Fi password and confirm.

A few confirmations with the terms of use are required at this time.

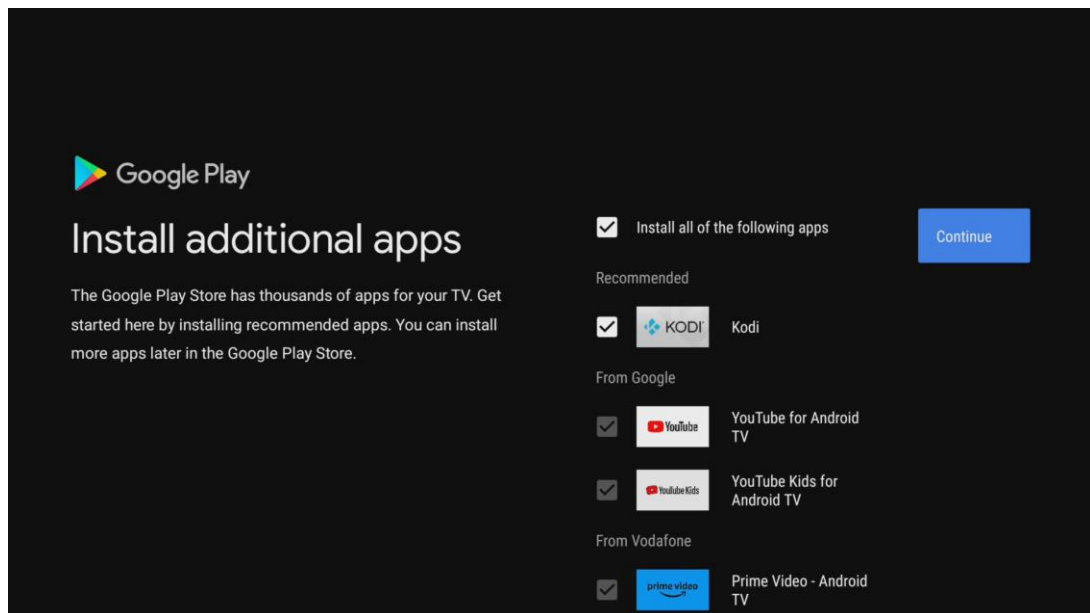

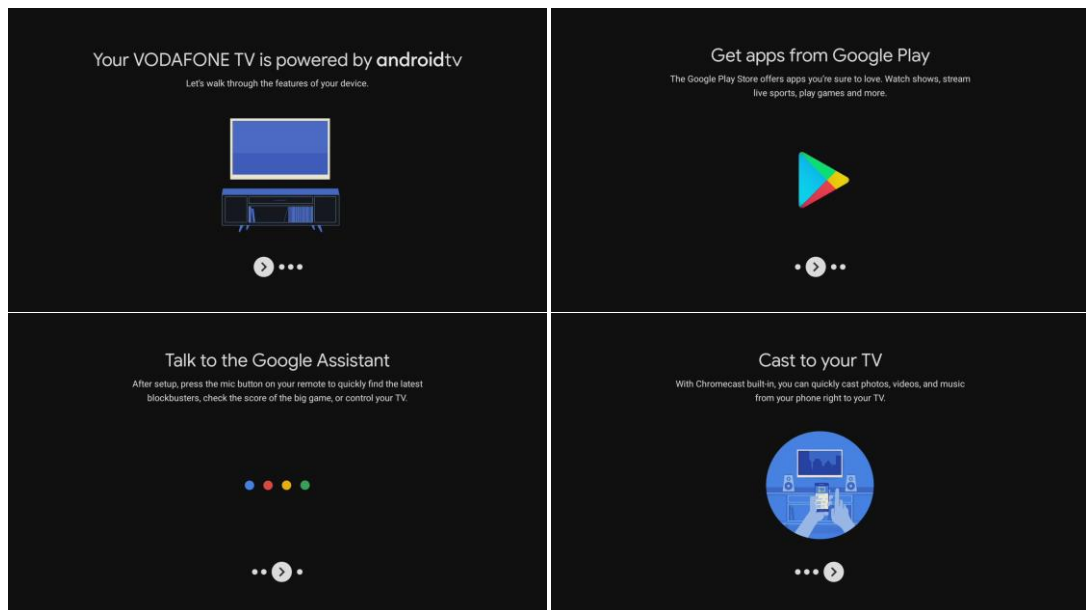
Then select the name of the device according to the location.

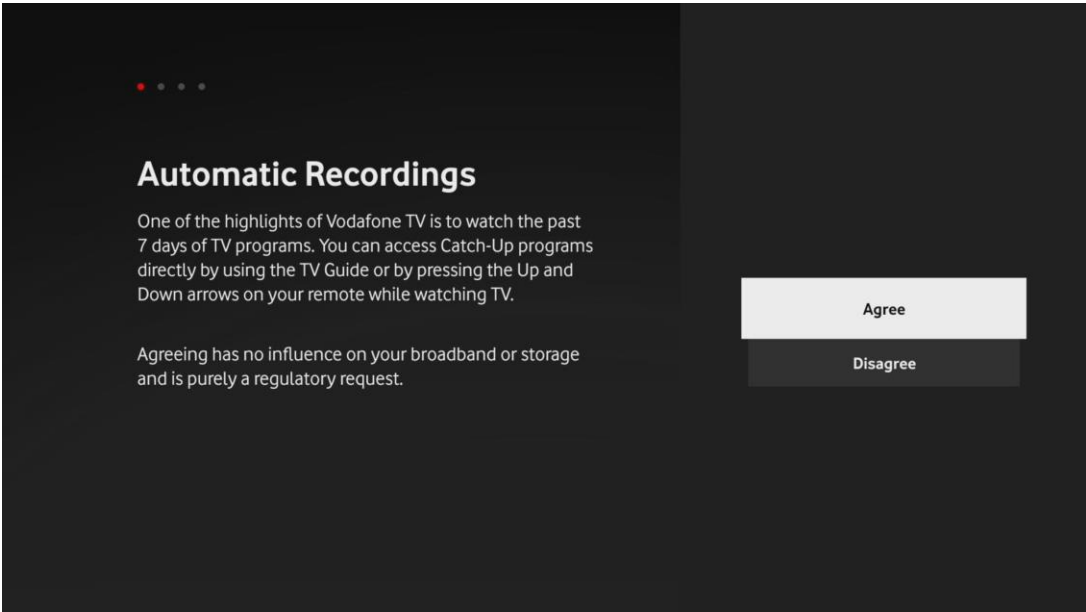
If you are logged in to a Google account, on the following screen you can choose which applications you want to install on the device.



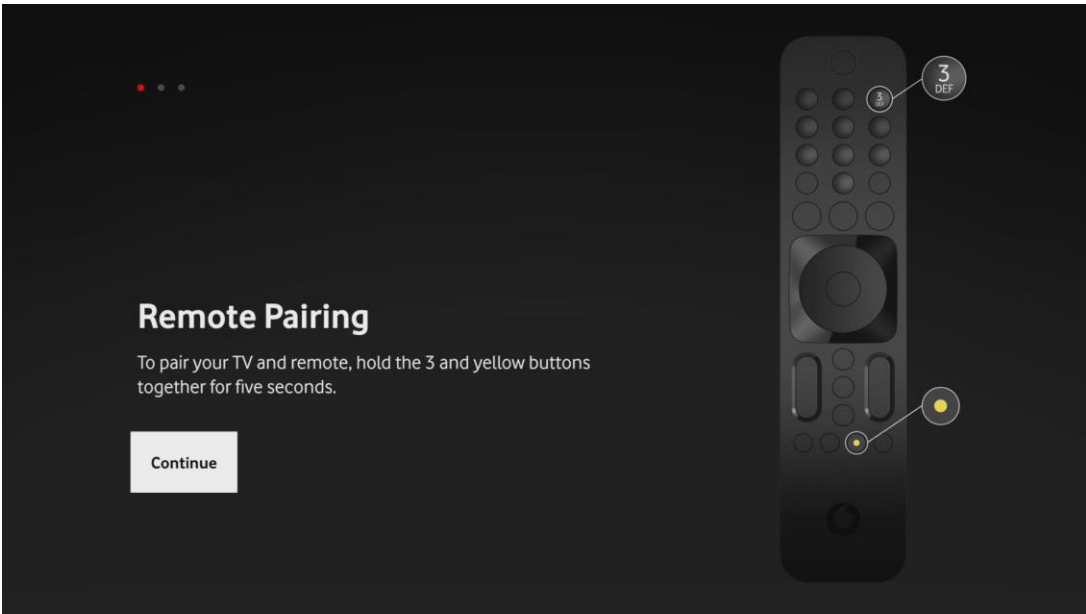
Now let's click through the device control information.



At this point, the setup of the device itself is complete, and the only thing left to do is set up the TV app itself.

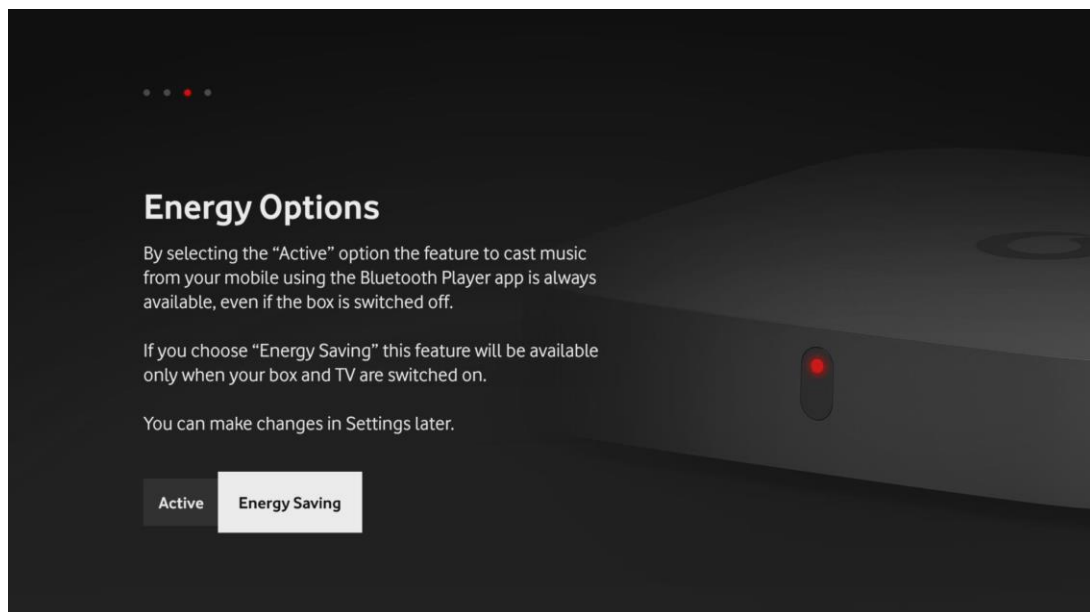


The first thing you need to do is agree to the Automatic recording option, which allows you to use the reverse viewing of programs.

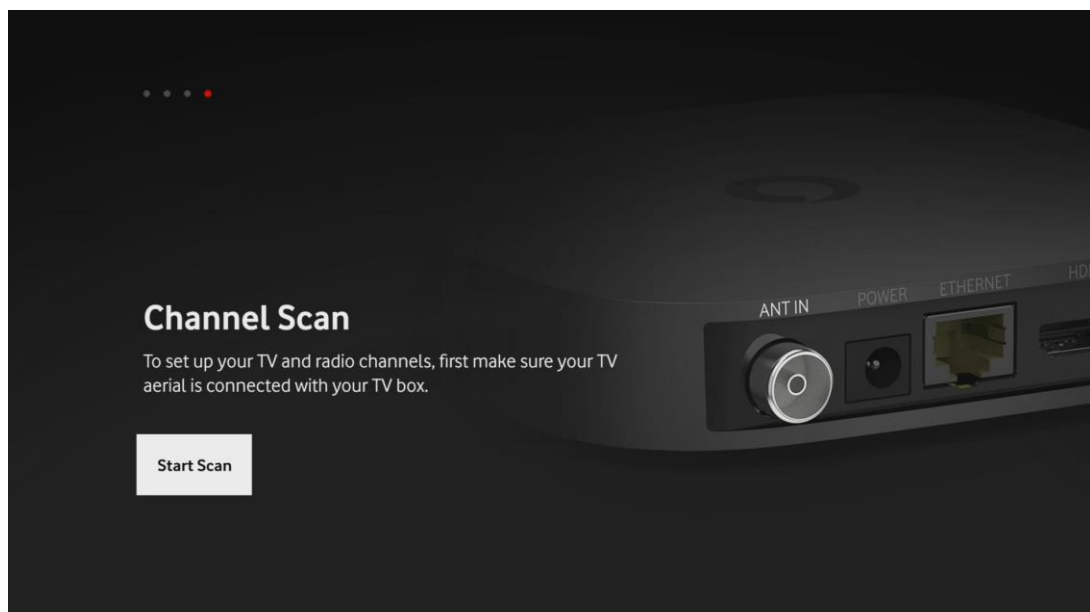


For full box functionality, please pair the controller according to the on-screen procedure.



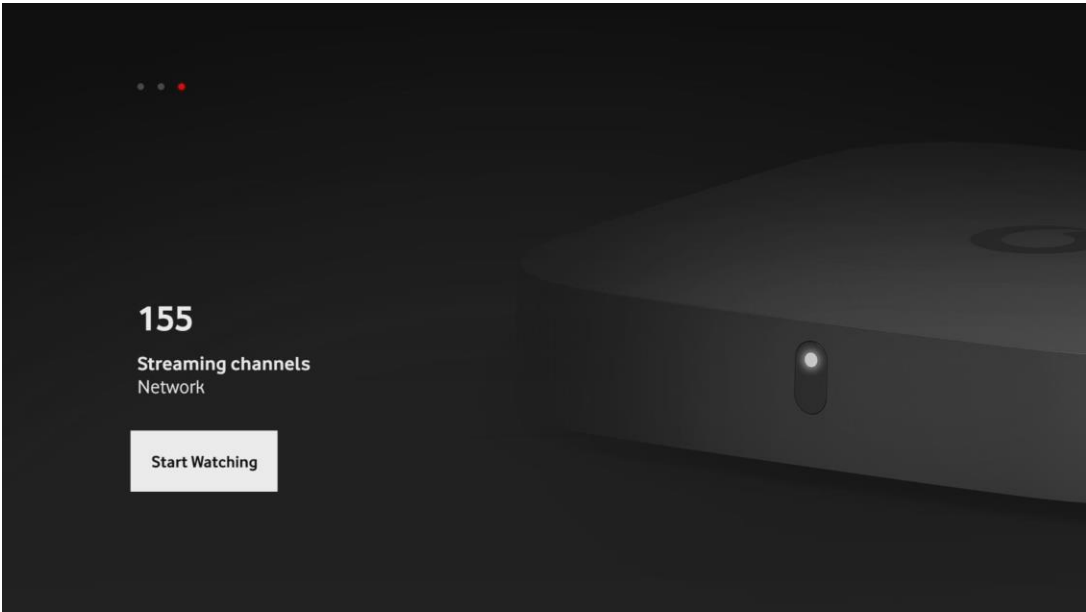


In the following option, you can choose whether you want the set-top box to be active all the time, or whether you prefer to save energy and select the energy-saving mode.
