


Connection of a premium set-top box

- OTT At least two cables must be connected from the back of the set-top box (power, HDMI and possibly Ethernet. See the picture below).
- VTV-C At least three cables must be connected from the back of the set-top box (power, HDMI, coaxial and possibly ethernet. See the image below).
- After connecting, the input on the TV must be switched correctly. (On HDMI 1, HDMI 2, etc., It depends to which connector in the TV is HDMI cable plugged into).
- **TIP**: We always recommend using an Ethernet cable if possible. (This is always a more stable option for connecting to the Internet).



- Power supply (connection: set-top box electrical socket).
- Ethernet cabel, if the set-top-box is not connected to the Wi-Fi (connection: set-top box modem).
- HDMI (connection: set-top box TV).
- Coaxial cable (connection: set-top box subscriber socket).
