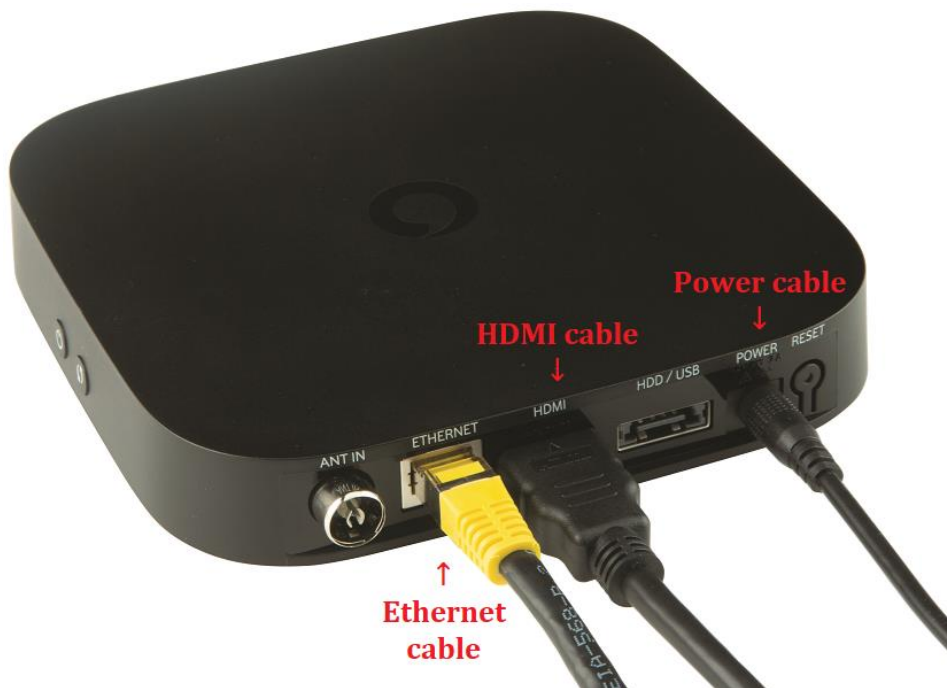




## Connection of a premium set-top box

- OTT – **At least two cables** must be connected from the back of the set-top box (power, HDMI and possibly Ethernet. **See the picture below**).
- VTV-C - **At least three cables** must be connected from the back of the set-top box (power, HDMI, coaxial and possibly ethernet. **See the image below**).
- After connecting, the input on the TV must be switched correctly. (On HDMI 1, HDMI 2, etc., It depends to which connector in the TV is HDMI cable plugged into).
- **TIP:** We always recommend using an Ethernet cable if possible. (This is always a more stable option for connecting to the Internet).



- Power supply (connection: set-top box – electrical socket).
- Ethernet cable, if the set-top-box is not connected to the Wi-Fi (connection: set-top box – modem).
- HDMI (connection: set-top box – TV).
- Coaxial cable (connection: set-top box - subscriber socket).
